Living in the Supernatural according to the Gifts of the Holy Spirit

Scriptures : Matthew 10:18; Ephesians 4:10-11; 1 Corinthians 12:1-11;; Acts 1:8; Luke 4:18; Matthew 5:13-14.

1. Wisdom {Gift of Wisdom}

What is wisdom? The application of knowledge. Equipped with business skills but with no viable and profitable business is lack of wisdom. Wisdom endows us with ability to know how to apply knowledge. Holy Spirit gives us supernatural understanding through His Word in diverse situations. Jesus was tempted in the wilderness, He ignored Satan and quoted God's Word. Eve in the garden failed to confront the lies of the devil & was deceived. Use word of wisdom to defeat the purposes of the Enemy by knowing how to apply the Word of God.

2. Word of knowledge

This comes supernaturally. God gave Daniel and his friends a super ability to understand sciences, languages and other knowledge. Receiving facts by the Spirit. Something that could not possibly be known without the prompting of the Holy Spirit. Given by the Holy Spirit, specific information concerning a need or problem. Acts 5:3-4 Ananias and Sapphira confronted by Peter. Can be personal or for benefit of others. When received, immediately praying for God's wisdom to share or apply.

3. Faith

Believe God for the impossible. Faith is the greatest of the power gifts. Exceptional ability to trust God. Depend on God in challenging situations. Three revelations of faith in the Bible: 1. Saving faith (Romans 5:1) measure of faith given to every person. 2. Fruit of faith (Galatians 5:22) planted by the Holy Spirit within all of us. 3. Gift of faith (1 Corinthians 12) comes for a moment, for a season and for a reason. The assurance of God's ability to act. Does not deny fact but changes it. God's promises become real to us more than our circumstances.

4. Healings:

To be endowed with power to perform miracles of healing. Restoration of health Soul, Spirit & Body. Gift of healings apply to both physical & emotional areas of life. The gifts also come in two ways, immediate and gradual. Healing restores what is broken. The Holy Spirit can use acts of faith to heal. The spoken word is used most often. Woman with an issue of blood healed by faith. Healing by laying on of hands. Healing by anointing with oil.

5. Working of miracles

Creative supernatural acts of God. Supernatural occurrence against laws of nature. God to turn back the Red Sea for children of Israel to walk on dry land. God's word will make us see the new dimension of creative miracles. Supernatural move of the Holy Spirit through the word of God {Psalm 33:6}. True miracles are a product of the word of God. Read, Understand, and Act on His Word, in order to move into the powerful of working of miracles.

6. Prophecy

Hearing God's voice & become able to communicate His thoughts & ideas to people. Revelation for edification
To Prophecy is to speak: Edification, Exhortation & Comfort to the people of God.
Prophecy: Builds us up, Encourages us, Stirs us up to pray & read God's Word. Comforts us. Not condemning.
Brings life & vision & light. Does not bring doom and gloom. Be completely consistent with the Scriptures.
Must not pronounce judgment and curses.

7. Discerning of spirits

{Crucial for the body of Christ}. Most Christians can exercise it. Keeps us safe. Gives us the ability deal with deception. Revelation gift working along with wisdom and knowledge. Perceiving the source of a manifestation whether it is from; God; Man, or the devil. Peter discern a man with wrong motives (Acts 8:18-24). We are in a battle with the cunning devil. Sometimes, evil masquerades as good.

8. Tongues

Three different kinds of tongues. 1. Tongues unto God; 1 Corinthians 14:2. 2. Tongues as a sign to those who are not yet saved; Acts 2. 3. Tongues that edify the body of believers; 1 Cor. 14:5. This gift is critical for intercession and spiritual warfare.

9. Interpretation of tongues

1 Corinthians 12:7 - This is when you or someone else is praying in tongues, and you know what they are saying and can interpret it to the church. Translation of divine utterances into recognisable language. crucial for edifying the body of believers and the church. This gift is similar to prophecy. important to understand this instruction in 1 Cor. 14:13. Requires spiritual maturity through 1. diligent prayer, 2. study of Scriptures, 3. intense time with the Holy Spirit.
