**Characteristics of a Transformed person**

Jeremiah 32: 38 – 40

- 1. Change of Identity – Become God's Person [Becoming God's Son and God's daughter]**
  - a. Scriptures: 1 Peter 2:1-12; John 1:12; 1 John 5:18; 2 Cor 5:21; Deuteronomy 32:10.
  - b. Importance of having the identity of God.
  - c. Challenges faced by a person who lacks God's identity.
  
- 2. God becomes your God – Belonging to God.**
  - a. Scriptures: Isaiah 8:19; Leviticus 19:31; Exodus 20:3 – 6; Deuteronomy 5:7-10.
  - b. Importance of belonging to God.
  - c. Challenges faced by a person who does not belong to God.
  
- 3. You will have one heart for God – Determined to follow God with passion.**
  - a. Scriptures : Matthew 15:8; Jeremiah 32:39; Romans 15:6; Luke 10:27; Mat 6:21; 1 Cor. 10:31.
  - b. What does it mean to be a determined person?
  - c. Challenges of lack of determination.
  
- 4. Strong focus on God [Soul being fully captured by God] Mind fully focused on God.**
  - a. Scriptures : John 14:6; 1 Thessalonians 4:1; Romans 8:9-11; Isaiah 26:3; Psalm 91:14-15.
  - b. What does it mean to be focused on God?
  - c. Challenges which make us not to be focused on God.
  
- 5. Fear God forever – Prominent goal of transformation is to fear God forever.**
  - a. Scriptures: Deuteronomy 5:29; Joshua 24:14; 1 Samuel 12:24; Luke 1:50.
  - b. Why must we fear God?
  - c. Challenges of lack of the fear of God – absence of the fear of God in a person's life.
  
- 6. Dedicate your families to God – Evidence of the rulership (Rule) of the kingdom God in the whole family.**
  - a. Scriptures : Col. 3:13; Psalm 133:1; Mark 10:9; Joshua 24: 14-15; 1 Tim 5:8; Prov 22:6; 2 Tim 3:16.
  - b. Benefits of the rulership of God in a family.
  - c. Challenges faced when there is no rulership of God in families.
  
- 7. Everlasting covenant with God - Being connected to eternal destiny.**
  - a. Scriptures : Jeremiah 32:40; Isaiah 55:3; Genesis 17:7;
  - b. What does it mean to have an everlasting covenant with God?
  - c. Challenges of not having an everlasting covenant with God.
